

NOTICE OF CONSULTATION

EYRE PENINSULA DESALINATION PLANT – BILLY LIGHTS POINT

APPLICATION FOR AUTHORISATIONS UNDER SECTIONS 21 AND 23 OF THE ABORIGINAL HERITAGE ACT 1988 (SA)

Consultation extended until Monday 3 February 2025.

The Minister for Aboriginal Affairs, who is responsible for the *Aboriginal Heritage Act 1988 (SA)* (Act), has received an application for authorisations under sections 21 and 23 of the Act from SA Water in relation to the construction of its proposed desalination plant at Billy Lights Point, south of Port Lincoln.

Section 21 makes it an offence to excavate land to uncover any Aboriginal site, object and/or ancestral remains (together, heritage) without authorisation under the Act, while section 23 makes it an offence to damage, disturb or interfere with heritage without authorisation under the Act.

The application area intersects one Aboriginal site for which records are held on central archives maintained by Aboriginal Affairs and Reconciliation (AAR). AAR is also aware of other Aboriginal sites – including fish traps, archaeological sites, an historic site, and an anthropological site – within 300 m of the application area.

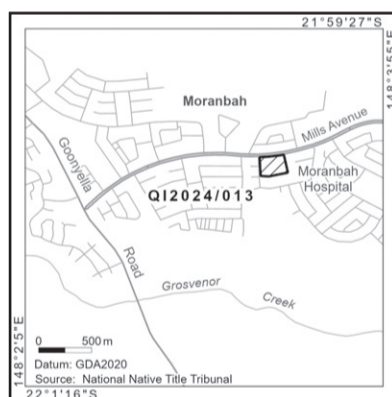
