The NSW Biodiversity Conservation Trust (BCT), as part of the Department of Planning, Industry & Environment (DPIE) cluster, has an exciting opportunity for a **Principal Aboriginal Partnerships Officer**.

This is an Aboriginal Identified role where Aboriginal identity, cultural knowledge or connections are a genuine aspect of the role. Positions are specifically noted under the provisions of the NSW Anti-discrimination Act (1977).

The Principal Aboriginal Partnerships Officer will be responsible for developing partnerships to enable, support and grow Aboriginal stakeholder participation in private land conservation with landholders across NSW, and enable two-way learning. The role will provide strategic guidance to the Branch and manage a small team.

The successful candidate will be able to demonstrate:

- Experience in development of successful partnerships with government, non-government corporate or philanthropic organisations that support healthy country outcomes for Aboriginal stakeholders
- Experience working with Aboriginal people, government organisations and communities with the ability to communicate across cultures.
- Understanding of the role and function of the BCT and NSW Government with respect to biodiversity conservation policy and legislation.

Essential Requirements

- Applicants must be of Aboriginal descent through parentage, identification as being Aboriginal and accepted in the community as such. Aboriginality is a genuine occupational qualification and is authorised under Section 14(d) of the *Anti-Discrimination Act 1997*.
- Current motor vehicle license
