Your role

The Minister for Family, Communities and Disabilities is seeking expressions of interest from individuals with expertise relevant to serious violent offenders within the Youth Justice system.

The Serious Young Offenders Review Panel provides independent advice to the Minister and Executive Director Youth Justice on issues related to serious violent offenders detained in juvenile detention centres in compliance with Part 4B of the *Children (Detention Centres) Act 1987*, and the Provisions issued under the Regulation.

The Minister will be appointing a member from the Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander community who can represent victims of crime.

Appointment will be for a 24-month term – convening the first Friday of each month (except January).

What we're looking for

Current NSW Working with Children Check clearance for paid employment.

The Child Protection (Working with Children) Act 2012 requires persons engaged in children related work to have Working with Children clearances. If successful in this role you will be required to provide a Working with Children Check clearance number prior to commencing in the role.
