### About the role

In this role, you will provide services, such as the facilitation of group based accredited or approved programs and individual support interventions for the people in our care to facilitate their safe, secure, and humane management and to reduce re-offending.

You will assist these people in our care with pre-release and oversee the documentation and case notes on all offenders receiving services as required.

This opportunity is for those who are truly passionate about making an impact upon the lives of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people. You can help achieve this by guiding your people to transform their lives through intervention and inclusion which in turn benefits the whole community.

### About you

We are seeking a proactive and dedicated individual with a background in social work, or professional experience working with individuals who display challenging behaviours.

A positive minded individual who is resilient by nature and able to effectively build positive relationships within a multidisciplinary team environment.

### Essential Requirements:

- Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander persons who are culturally aware and responsive to the needs of Aboriginal people and their communities
- Aboriginality with connection and understanding to community and country
- Documented verification of Aboriginality
- Demonstrated experience working with family, social and / or drug and alcohol related issues
- Current driver licence with ability and willingness to travel throughout NSW

The Department will accept proof of Aboriginality confirming the following:

1. You are an Aboriginal person of Aboriginal descent
2. You identify as being Aboriginal; and
3. You are accepted as such by the community in which you live

An acceptable form of documented verification is a "Confirmation of Aboriginality" letter, provided to you by an Aboriginal organisation on their letterhead.

### Applying for the role

To apply, you must have:

- One-page cover letter that tells us about you and your connection to the community
- Provide an up-to-date resume of no more than 3 pages
- Nominate of 2 referees
- Have confirmation of Aboriginality
