



PROPOSAL TO GRANT PETROLEUM EXPLORATION PERMIT

SECTION 29 NATIVE TITLE ACT 1993 (COMMONWEALTH)

The application is located in the Northern Carnarvon Basin, near the townsite of Onslow. It extends along the coastline between Tubridgi Point and Cape Preston, west of the North-West Coastal Highway. The application includes 79.5' x 5' graticular blocks; all within the one million map sheet SF50 (Hamersley Range) for a total area of 6291.9 km². The north-east corner of the application (116°10'4.68"E ; 20°54'55.19"S) of the application is located in the coastal waters, approximately 10 kilometres south-west of Cape Preston and about 27.5 kilometres north-east of Balmoral homestead. The south-west corner of the application (114°45'4.70"E ; 22°4'55.36"S) is situated at approximately 32 kilometres north-west of Hope Point and about 62 kilometres south-west of Onslow. A technical description of the boundaries of the proposed permit area can be provided on request.

Nature of the act: The proposed act is the grant of a petroleum exploration permit pursuant to section 32 of the *Petroleum and Geothermal Energy Resources Act 1967 (WA)*. The permit, if granted, will authorise the permittee to explore for petroleum, and to carry on such operations and execute such works as are necessary for that purpose in the permit area for a term of 6 years from the date the grant becomes effective and to apply for renewals of the permit.





Background

The area that is the subject of the NNWW Claim is bounded by the towns of Brewarrina, Bourke, Coonamble, Gulargambone, Warren, Nyngan, Hillston, Mossiel and Ivanhoe, from the Barwon River in the north, to the Lachlan River in the south, the Castlereagh River in the east and Ivanhoe in the west

The Applicant in the NNWW Claim ('current Applicant') comprises the following persons:

The current Applicant was authorised to act on behalf of the NNWW Claim Group at a claim group meeting on 24 and 25 November 2018.

Reasons for the NNWW Claim Group Meeting

1. Replacement of the current Applicant – NNWW Claim Group instructions on an application under section 66B of the *Native Title Act*

Sadly, in March 2020, Uncle Neville Merritt passed away.

Accordingly, at this NNWW Claim Group meeting the NNWW Claim Group will be asked to consider and make decisions to authorise a new Applicant. This could involve:

- i. reauthorising the 9 living members of the current Applicant to act as Applicant without Uncle Neville Merritt; or
- ii. nominating and confirming one person to replace Uncle Neville and reauthorising the 9 members of the current applicant as well as the one additional person; or
- iii. any new composition of NNWW Claim Group members as the NNWW Claim Group decides.

2. Authorisation of the Applicant to enter into a section 31 Deeds and Ancillary Agreements

Peel Mining have applied for Minister's Consent to prospect on any land or waters on which native title has not been extinguished within Exploration Licences 7461 (near Gilgumnia) and 6695 (about 25km north west of Mount Hope).

Tritton Resources Pty Limited have applied for Minister's Consent to prospect on any land or waters on which native title has not been extinguished within Exploration Licence 4962 (about 50km west of Nyngan).

Under the Native Title Act, the NNWW Applicant has a right to negotiate with Peel Mining and Tritton Resources in relation to the grant of Minister's Consent (but not to veto).

The Applicant has negotiated separate in principle agreements with each of Tritton Resources and Peel Mining.

The in principle agreements include a package of financial and non-financial compensation in exchange for the consent of the Applicant to the grant of Minister's Consent.

In April 2021, Peel Mining lodged a future act determination application in the National Native Title Tribunal in relation to the grant of Minister's Consent.

At this Claim Group Meeting the NNWW Claim Group will be asked whether or not they wish to authorise the Applicant to enter into the Agreements with Peel Mining and Tritton Resources.

2. Update on developments in relation to the NNWW Claim
3. Confirmation of the relevant decision-making process for the members of the NNWW Claim Group

4. Research Presentation on Claim Group Description

- b. Discussion around Ms Crowe's research and findings in relation to the Claim Group Description.

5. Instructions on the Native Title Claim *Commercial rights and exclusive rights*

- (a) Discussion and background on commercial rights and exclusive rights in relation to the Claim Area and the progress so far, including update on negotiation with the NSW Government and information regarding the possible next steps which can be pursued; and
- (b) Following this discussion, the NNWW Claim Group will consider and make a decision as to which option they instruct the Applicant to pursue.

Tenure Proposal

- (a) Discussion and background on tenure proposal and s 47B of the Native Title Act;
- (b) Discussion and information regarding the possible next steps which can be pursued; and
- (c) Following this discussion, the NNWW Claim Group will consider and make a decision whether or not to instruct the Applicant to pursue the tenure proposal.

6. Peel Mining Agreement

- (a) Discussion and background on the negotiations between Peel Mining and the Applicant in relation to the Wagga Tank and Mallee Bull Exploration areas.
- (b) Discussion and information regarding the in-principle Agreement which has been negotiated.
- (c) Following this discussion, the NNWW Claim Group will consider and make a decision whether or not to:
 - a. instruct the NNWW Applicant to execute the Peel Mining Agreement; and
 - b. instruct the Applicant to consent to a determination by the National Native Title Tribunal that Minister's Consent may be granted.

7. Tritton Resources Agreement

- (a) Discussion and background on the negotiations between Tritton Resources and the Applicant in relation to the Budgery Exploration area.
- (b) Discussion and information regarding the in-principle Agreement which has been negotiated.
- (c) Following this discussion, the NNWW Claim Group will consider and make a decision whether or not to instruct the NNWW Applicant to execute the Tritton Resources Agreement.

8. Authorisation of new Applicant.

- (a) Discussion and making decisions on whether the NNWW Claim Group wishes to reauthorise the 9 living members of the current Applicant to be the Applicant; or nominate and confirm one person to replace Uncle Neville Merritt and reauthorise the 9 living members of the current Applicant as well as the one additional person to be the Applicant; or nominate any new composition of NNWW Claim Group members to be the Applicant.
- (b) The NNWW Claim Group will consider resolutions and make decisions to authorise a new Applicant. The NNWW Claim Group will be asked to authorise the new Applicant to make an application to the Federal Court for an order under section 66B of the Native Title Act 1993 (Cth) that the new Applicant replace the current Applicant.
- (c) The NNWW Claim Group will be asked to consider resolutions and make decisions about placing conditions on the powers of the Applicant including in relation to the Applicant's ability to enter into commercial and other agreements which may affect the NNWW Claim Group's native title rights and interests.
- (d) The NNWW Claim Group will be asked to consider and make decisions about whether to give instructions to the Applicant about the processes it must undertake in making its decisions. For example, whether or not the Applicant can make decisions by majority, and whether the Applicant can nominate certain members of the Applicant to sign documents on behalf of the Applicant.

Any other matters, as determined by members of the NNWW Claim Group.
