AGENDA & PURPOSE OF THE MEETING

Background


NTS Goldfields Ltd (NTSG) is arranging this meeting to provide an opportunity to discuss and consider authorising a new native title claim over the area displayed in the map below. This meeting follows on from the series of meetings convened by NTSG in 2020 and earlier in 2021. At those meetings NTSG discussed the people identified by Dr Heather Lynes as having a traditional connection to the area. An agreed outcome of the meeting convened in March 2021 was that NTSG would conduct further research into other persons asserting rights and interests in the area. Following this further research, NTSG would convene another meeting where a proposed new claim would be considered for authorisation.

Before a new native title claim is filed in the Federal Court of Australia, those people who hold native title rights and interests over the proposed claim area must 'authorise' one or more members of the native title claim group to make the claim and to deal with matters arising in relation to it. The meeting at which those decisions are made is called an 'Authorisation Meeting'.

The purpose of the meeting is to **discuss, consider and make decisions** about:

1. Authorising a new native title claim in the Federal Court of Australia over the area shown in the map below (**Claim area and boundary**);
2. The **Claim Group Description** – who are the people who are included in the claim;
3. The **decision-making process** of the claim group;
4. Authorising a person or people, to be the '**Applicant**' and the scope of the Applicant's authority. It is the Applicant's role to make the native title claim on behalf of all the people in the native title claim group, and to deal with matters arising in relation to the claim;
5. A **claim name** – the claim group will need to decide on a name which will be used by the Courts and other parties to refer to the claim; and
6. **Other business**



Day One: Monday 16 August

- Consider authorising a new claim group description for the Marlinyu Ghoorlie native title claim WAD 647 of 2017 in the Federal Court of Australia (see map below) in the following terms:

The persons on whose behalf the application is made are those Aboriginal people who:

- are descended from one or more of the following ancestors (including by adoption in accordance with the traditional laws and customs of the rights-holding group): (a) Nellie Champion; (b) Kadee; (c) Warada; and (d) Lucy Sambo; **or** though not descended from those ancestors, have been incorporated into the rights-holding group in accordance with the traditional laws and customs of the rights-holding group, or are descended from persons who have been so incorporated; **and**
- identify themselves as Kalamia, Gubrun, Kapurn or Kalaako (including alternate spellings of these names) or any combination thereof; **and**
- are recognised by the other members of the rights-holding group as members of that group in accordance with the traditional laws and customs of the group.

Note: The inclusion of an ancestor's name in [1] above indicates that the ancestor's descendants are recognised as members of the rights-holding group either on the basis of descent or on the basis of incorporation."

2. Authorising persons to be (or to continue to be) the Applicant for the Marlinyu Ghoorlie Claim, to make the application and to deal with matters arising in relation to it.

The current members of the Applicant are Brian Champion Snr, Henry Richard Dimer, Maxine Dimer, James Champion, Raelene Peel, Darren Indich and Simon Champion. Making any changes to this list would involve passing a resolution that the current applicants are no longer authorised, and a further resolution which authorises a new set of applicants.

3. Deciding what conditions (if any) to place on the authority of the Applicant

New amendments to the Native Title Act expressly allow for conditions to be placed on native title applicants, with those conditions then being recorded in the claim. These could include conditions about specific matters, as well as general conditions (eg. a condition requiring the Applicant to act in accordance with resolutions made at future claim group meetings, including resolutions passed on the second day of this meeting).

Day Two: Tuesday 17 August

- Consider whether the Marlinyu Ghoorlie Applicant should support the grant of exploration licence E77/2521 and any subsequent mining lease over that same area. 5,992 ha of the area covered by E77/2521 falls within the currently-proposed boundaries of Stage 2 of the Helena Aurora National Park.
- Consider whether the Applicant should enter into negotiations for an Indigenous Land Use Agreement authorizing Stage 2 of the Helena Aurora National Park, and (if so) on what conditions.
- Presentation by Olive Branch Enterprises Pty Ltd.
- Marlinyu Ghoorlie Trust Structure

Some of the matters listed for the first day may be put over to the second day, if this cannot reasonably be avoided.

If the proposed amendment to the claim group description is not approved by a meeting of the current Marlinyu Ghoorlie claim group on the morning of 16 August, the first day of this meeting will be cancelled, but the second day will still go ahead, in order for all those invited to make non-binding decisions on the Day 2 agenda items.

Subject to funding, TA at a fixed rate of \$300.00 per person will be available to meeting participants travelling from more than 500ks from Coolgardie.

In the event of Covid restrictions impacting attendance, the meeting may be cancelled, or arrangements may be made for virtual attendance from one or more regional centres.





NOTICE OF IMPORTANT AUTHORISATION MEETINGS Cape York United # 1 Native Title Claim (QUD673/2014)



Cape York Land Council invites all people who are members of the native title claim group for the Cape York United #1 native title claim (CYU#1 Claim), a claim for the area shown on the map to the right, to attend native title Authorisation Meetings in relation to the CYU#1 Claim that will be held in July and August 2021.

The current terms of the authorisation of the Applicant in the CYU#1 Claim require the **whole** of the claim group to authorise every native title determination that is made in relation to the CYU#1 Claim. Determinations are now timetabled to be made from November 2021 onwards, and they will take place until all parts of the CYU#1 Claim have been part of a native title determination. A proposal to change the current terms of authorisation in the CYU#1 Claim would allow native title determination in the CYU#1 Claim to be made one by one as each native title group within the area covered by the CYU#1 Claim reaches agreement with their neighbours on boundaries, and amongst themselves on things such as the group description of the group for the native title determination in question and the prescribed body corporate which will then manage the native title.

The purpose of the Authorisation Meetings is to decide whether or not to change the current terms of authorisation of the Applicant in the CYU#1 Claim. The agenda of each meeting will be to consider whether the native title claim group for the CYU#1 Claim wishes to:

- agree and adopt a decision-making process;
- authorise the Applicant in the CYU#1 Claim to agree to a consent determination in an area within the area covered by the CYU#1 Claim if, and only if, the native title group for the area covered by the consent determination in question has first approved the determination as a draft;
- otherwise continue the original resolutions from 2014 which authorised the CYU#1 Claim to be made;
- when a member of the Applicant passes away or resigns, the authority of remaining members of the Applicant is to continue.








