Background

The Eastern Maar Peoples have made a claimant application to the Federal Court of Australia seeking recognition of their native title rights and interests under the Native Title Act 1993 (Cth) ('NTA'). The claim is called *Ivan Couzens & Ors on behalf of the Eastern Maar Peoples* (VID21/2019) ('Native Title Claim'). This is an authorisation meeting to consider proposed amendments to the existing claim as described below.

Notice under Section 29 of the Native Title Act 1993 Exploration Licence Number 8521 (Act 1992)

This notice is given in accordance with the requirements of section 29 of the Native Title Act 1993 (Commonwealth).

Description of the nature of the act

Pursuant to the *Native Title (Right to Negotiate (Exclusion) – NSW Land) Determination No. 1 of 1996 (Cth)*, Exploration Licence 8521 includes a condition to the effect that the holder must not prospect on any land or waters covered by that licence in relation to which native title exists without the prior written consent of the Deputy Premier, Minister for Regional NSW (the ‘Native Title Condition’).

The licence contains a condition that the holder must not prospect on any land or waters on which native title exists without the prior consent of the Minister administering the *Mining Act 1992*. The licence holder has sought the Minister’s consent to conduct prospecting activities in part of the licence area.
