



9.1 The Parties acknowledge that the Project may require:

9.1.1 the revocation, dedication, or re-dedication, of all or part of the Agreement Area pursuant to the provisions of the *Crown Land Management Act 2009* (SA).

9.1.2 the grant by the Minister for Environment and Water of one or more licences over part of the Agreement Area to permit and facilitate the construction of the Project.

9.1.3 the grant by the Minister for Environment and Water of a lease over a portion of the Agreement Area to permit and facilitate the ongoing operation of the Project.

9.1.4 the grant by the Minister for Transport of a licence for construction purposes over portion of the Agreement Area to facilitate the ongoing operation of the Project.

9.1.5 the making of regulations under the HNA to declare some or all of the ILUA Area to be a harbor and port under the Act.

9.1.6 the Minister for Transport giving approval to the Company, or another entity nominated by the Company, being the designated port operator in relation to the Project.

9.1.7 the Minister for Transport and the agreed port operator entering into a Port Operating Agreement.

9.2 For the avoidance of doubt, the Parties acknowledge and agree that the interests contemplated by clause 9.1 may be granted to the Company or to another entity nominated by the Company, including its contractors and agents.

12.1 *[NAC and the Narungga People consent, without conditions, to the acts referred to in clause 9 (including any act or activity done pursuant to those acts) and any other act or activity on the Agreement Area reasonably necessary for the construction and operation of the Project on the Agreement Area].*

14. *[The Parties agree that Subdivision P of Division 3 of Part 2 of the Native Title Act 1993 (Cth) (the right to negotiate) is not intended to apply to the acts consented to in clause 12.1].*

HNA or Act means the *Harbors and Navigation Act 1993* (SA);

[Narungga People] means the Narungga native title claim group as set out in the Form 1 with respect to the Narungga Native Title Claim SAD62/2013, or where there is a Determination of Native Title over all or part of the Agreement Area, means the common law Native Title holders for that Determination];

Port Operating Agreement means a port operating agreement made pursuant to Division 1 of Part 5 of the HNA;
