


# NOTICE OF PROPOSED GRANT OF MINING LEASE

## NATIVE TITLE ACT 1993 (CTH) SECTION 29

The Queensland Minister for Resources, PO Box 15216, City East, Queensland, 4002, hereby gives notice in accordance with section 29 of the *Native Title Act 1993 (Cth)* of the proposed grant of Mining Lease (ML) 100297 shown below under the *Mineral Resources Act 1989 (Qld)*.

Mining Lease 100297 sought by Graham Edward Elmes and Jocelyn Anne Elmes, over an area of 23.46 ha, centred approximately 9.5 km Southeast of Lakeland, in the locality of the Cook Shire Council.










