

University of Newcastle, Gosford – Central Coast Campus Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Assessment – Community Consultation Stage 1.3



URBIS has been commissioned by the University of Newcastle ('the Proponent') to conduct an Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Assessment (ACHA) for 305 Mann Street, Gosford, within the Central Coast Local Government Area (LGA) ('the subject area'). The subject area is the site of the newly proposed Central Coast Campus of the University of Newcastle. The subject area is legally described as:

Lots 1, 2, 4, 29, 30 and 32 of Section 1 in Deposited Plan 1591.

Lot 1 in Deposited Plan 91163.

Lot 1 in Deposited Plan 91164.

The proposed works are to be undertaken as a State Significant Development Application (SSDA) and will include the demolition of existing structures, excavation and bulk earthworks for site levelling, and construction of a new educational building on the western portion of the subject area with provision of open public space to the east.

The ACHA is to be carried out in accordance with relevant guidelines under the National Parks and Wildlife Act 1974 (NPW Act). The assessment will detail any potential Aboriginal cultural heritage resources within the subject area and provide recommendations regarding management of those resources.



Background

The Eastern Maar Peoples have made a claimant application to the Federal Court of Australia seeking recognition of their native title rights and interests under the Native Title Act 1993 (Cth) ('NTA'). The claim is called *Ivan Couzens & Ors on behalf of the Eastern Maar Peoples (VID21/2019)* ('Native Title Claim'). This is an authorisation meeting to consider proposed amendments to the existing claim as described below, as well as other associated matters requiring the consideration of the native title claim group.

AGENDA & PURPOSE OF THE MEETING

The purpose of this meeting is to provide an opportunity for Wadawurrung Traditional Owners to discuss and consider authorising a new native title determination application covering the area displayed on the map (Proposed Claim Area). This meeting follows on from the series of meetings convened in 2021 and earlier in 2022, where filing of a native title determination application was discussed.

Before a new native title determination application is filed in the Federal Court of Australia, those people who claim to hold native title rights and interest in relation to the proposed application area must 'authorise' one or more members of the native title claim group to make the native title determination application and to deal with matters arising in relation to it. The meeting at which those decisions are made is called an 'Authorisation Meeting'. This meeting is to be held for that purpose.

The Agenda for this Authorisation Meeting is:

1. Welcome to Country and introductions;
2. To discuss, consider and make decisions in relation to the decision-making process of the claim group for the purpose of authorising the making of a Wadawurrung native title determination application and dealing with matters arising in relation to it;
3. To discuss, consider and make decisions whether the people present at the meeting are sufficiently representative of Wadawurrung Traditional Owners to be able to make decisions including authorising the making of the proposed native title determination application;
4. To discuss, consider and make decisions in relation to authorising a new native title determination application to be filed in the Federal Court of Australia covering the area shown in the map (Proposed Claim Area);
5. To discuss, consider and make decisions to authorise a person or persons, to be the 'Applicant'. It is the Applicant's role to make the native title determination application on behalf of all the people in the native title claim group, and to deal with matters arising in relation to the application under the *Native Title Act 1993* (Cth);
6. To discuss, consider and make decisions whether the authority of the Applicant should be subject to conditions, and, if so, what conditions; and
7. To discuss, consider and decide a name for the application - the claim group will need to decide on a name which will be used by the courts and other parties to refer to the application.

PEOPLE WHO SHOULD ATTEND THE MEETING

The meeting is open to all members of the Wadawurrung native title claim group, being all persons who:


- a) are biological descendants of apical ancestor, John Robinson (also known as John Robertson); and
