

297 King Street, Mascot, NSW Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Assessment – Community Consultation Stage 1



Urbis has been commissioned by LOGOS Property Group ('the proponent') to conduct an Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Assessment (ACHA) for 297 King Street, Mascot, NSW, legally referred to as Lot 103 DP 1282564 and Lots 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 DP 234489 ('the subject area'). The subject area is within the Bayside Local Government Area (LGA), on the traditional land of the Gadigal and Bidjigal, and within the bounds of the Metropolitan Local Aboriginal Land Council (LALC).

The ACHA will support a State Significant Development Application (SSDA) for the proposed development of the subject area. The proposed works consist of the demolition of the existing structures and construction of a warehouse within Lots 2 and 4 DP 234489 with approximately 29,200m² of warehouse space and 2,620m² of ancillary office space over five levels. There will be excavation involved in the construction of the building. Lot 103 DP 1282564 will provide ancillary car parking to meet the needs of the development, including both the warehouse and office components. There is the potential for ancillary landscaping works to be undertaken in Lots 1, 3 and 5 DP 234489.





