



In order to resolve native title issues with respect to the Wangkamahdla Part B Application and settle the proceedings by agreement, the Wangkamahdla People propose to enter into an Indigenous Land Use Agreement (Area Agreement) (**Proposed ILUA**) pursuant to the *Native Title Act* with the State of Queensland (**State**) and the Mulligan River Aboriginal Corporation (**MRAC**).

The Proposed ILUA covers Lot 2 on CP904679; Lot 1 on SP107130; Lot 2 on SP107130; Lot 3 on SP107130; Lot 4 on SP107130; and Lot 5 on SP107130 located just north of the town of Bedourie, comprising a total area of 92.51 hectares (**ILUA Area**). The ILUA Area is wholly within the external boundaries of the Wangkamahdla Part B Application and is depicted on the **Map**.



The terms of the Proposed ILUA provide for: (i) consent to the doing of certain agreed acts; (ii) validation of certain prior acts; (iii) surrender of native title rights and interests within the ILUA Area; and (iv) payment of compensation by the State to MRAC on behalf of the Wangkamahdla People.


