

## OTWAY OFFSHORE PROJECT UPDATE



### Thylacine Wells Subsea Installation and Commissioning

Beach Energy is continuing development of the Otway Offshore Project to ensure ongoing production at the Otway Gas Plant (near Port Campbell), which principally supplies natural gas to Victorian households and businesses.

#### Recently Completed Activities

From February 2021 to July 2022, Beach safely and successfully completed drilling seven offshore natural gas wells, with two of the new wells already connected to the existing Otway Gas Plant through the existing offshore pipeline.

#### Near Term Activities

A specialist construction support vessel and remote operated vehicle will be used to install additional seabed infrastructure in water depths of around 100m to connect four new wells in the Thylacine field, which has been producing natural gas since 2007. This activity represents Phase 5 in the development of the Otway Offshore Project.

#### Timing

Starting approximately February 2023, the activities will take around nine weeks. Timings will be confirmed after further regulatory approvals are received and subject to vessel availability and weather conditions.

#### Location

The activities will occur approximately 68 km south of Port Campbell in Commonwealth waters.

#### Safety and Environment Protection

All activities will be carried out in accordance

with applicable safety and environment legislation and an Environment Plan that must be accepted by the National Offshore Petroleum Safety Management Authority (NOPSEMA) before the activities commence.

Other vessels in the area will be required to observe safety exclusion zones around the wells and construction vessel and a Notice to Mariners will be issued before the activities commence.

Consultation is an important part of developing Environment Plans. Please contact us if you would like further information or to consult with us about how this project may affect your functions, interests or activities.

Beach will consider appropriate measures that may arise from consultations and will respond to all questions and concerns. Consultation records will be provided to NOPSEMA and published with the Environment Plan, unless you advise you don't want that information published.

Should consent be granted, the licence holder may apply to renew or transfer the licence prior to it expiring (including partial renewals or partial transfers).

**Note:** If the consent is granted, the renewal, re grant or re-making (including partial renewals or partial transfers) or extension of the term of the licence may be valid pursuant to section 24MD(1) of the *Native Title Act 1993* (Cth) without further notification, provided the requirements in section 26D(1) are satisfied.

### Holder's details

Godolphin Tenements Pty Ltd (ACN 634 219 999) is the holder of Exploration Licence 8580 for Group 1 minerals. The licence contains a condition that the holder must not prospect on any land or waters on which native title exists without the prior consent of the Minister administering the *Mining Act 1992*. The licence holder has sought the Minister's consent to conduct prospecting activities across the licence area.


