













Notice of intention to consult with and seek the consent of Yirendali common law holders to enter into a Community Benefits Agreement

North Queensland Renewable Energy Zone Pty Ltd (**NQREZ**) and the Yirendali Aboriginal Corporation (ICN: 8398) (**Yirendali AC**) are proposing to enter into a Community Benefits Agreement (the **Agreement**) in relation to the proposed Mount James Wind Farm, located 80km north of Hughenden (the **Project**) as shown on the map below.

Under the proposed Agreement, in return for the benefits provided by NQREZ, Yirendali AC acknowledge:

1. that the parties consulted and cooperated in good faith and obtained the free, prior and informed consent of the Yirendali people in relation to the Project; and
2. that any public entity's decision to grant a Project Right will be a decision that is not incompatible with the Yirendali People's Cultural Rights.

The Yirendali AC seek to consult with and seek the consent of the Yirendali People to enter into the Agreement.





NOTICE OF MEETING OF BARNGARLA NATIVE TITLE HOLDERS TO CONSIDER PROPOSED INDIGENOUS LAND USE AGREEMENT UNDER THE NATIVE TITLE ACT 1993 (CTH) and TO CONSIDER MAKING OF NATIVE TITLE DECISION UNDER THE NATIVE TITLE (PRESCRIBED BODIES CORPORATE) REGULATIONS 1999 (CTH)

Decision 1: Proposed ILUA

The Barngarla Determination Aboriginal Corporation RNTBC ICN 8603 (**BDAC**) and the Minister for Climate, Environment and Water (**Minister**) propose to enter into an Indigenous Land Use Agreement (Body Corporate Agreement) (**ILUA**) pursuant to Subdivision B of Division 3 of Part 2 of the *Native Title Act 1993 (Cth)* (**NT Act**).

The proposed ILUA covers the land in the area set out in the map contained in this notice. The land is in and around the Cultana Industrial Estate and is presently described as:

- Allotment 5 in Deposited Plan 125055, Allotments 1-2 in Deposited Plan 42001;
- Allotment pieces 3, 5 and 6-11 in Deposited Plan 42001;
- Sections 39, 40, 42, 43, 44, 46, 47, 48, 49, 50 and 51 in the Hundred of Cultana.
(the ILUA Area)

What is the ILUA for?

The ILUA will allow BDAC to take ownership of the land within the ILUA Area in fee simple (commonly known as freehold title). The Minister has agreed to transfer this land to BDAC in accordance with section 25(f) of the Crown Land Management Act 2009 (SA) (**CLMA**). After the transfer occurs, BDAC will then be the freehold owner of the land within the ILUA Area. BDAC will then be able to grant one or more commercial leases over the land within the ILUA Area. It is proposed that BDAC will grant a commercial lease over portion of the land to the South Australian State Government for its proposed Hydrogen Power Plant Project.

The ILUA requires the Barngarla People to surrender native title over the ILUA Area, in order to facilitate the grant of fee simple title to BDAC. The surrender of native title will occur at the moment that the land in the ILUA Area is transferred to BDAC.

Decision 2: Consent to Easement

BDAC is seeking the approval of the common law holders for granting its consent under section 28(2) of the *Crown Land Management Act 2009 (SA)* (**CLMA**) for an easement required for the connection of the South Australian State Government Hydrogen Power Plant to the Cultana Substation.

This consent is a Native Title Decision which will apply to part of Allotment 67 DP93251 and may also apply to part of section 14 in the Hundred of Cultana (**Easement Land**) both of which are native title land.

Who should attend this meeting?

The common law holders for the ILUA Area and the Easement Land are the Barngarla native title holders (**Barngarla People**). The Barngarla People as determined by the Federal Court of Australia are those persons:

- who are related by means of the principle of descent to the following Barngarla apical ancestors:
 - the siblings Percy Richards and Susie Richards;
 - Maudie Blade who is the mother of Phyllis Croft;
 - George Glennie and Mary Glennie;
 - the siblings Bob Eyles and Harry Croft;
 - Jack Stuart;
 - Arthur Davis (also known as King Arthur) and his sons, Andrew Davis, Jack Davis, Stanley Davis and Percy Davis; and
- who have a connection with the Determination Area in accordance with the traditional laws and customs of the Barngarla People; and
- who identify as a Barngarla person and who are accepted by the Barngarla People as a Barngarla person.

BDAC is the Registered Native Title Body Corporate for the ILUA Area and the Easement Land. Accordingly, pursuant to *section 24BD* of the NT Act, it must be a party to the ILUA. BDAC is required to consult with the Barngarla People under the *Native Title (Prescribed Bodies Corporate) Regulations 1999 (Cth)* (**PBC Regulations**) before making a Native Title Decision. Any member of the Barngarla People as defined by the Federal Court, is eligible to be a member of BDAC. Under the BDAC Rule Book, only Barngarla People can be members of BDAC. Accordingly, any member of BDAC (who by definition will also be a Barngarla native title holder) may attend this meeting.


