Expedited procedure: The State of Western Australia considers that these acts are acts attracting the expedited procedure. Each licence may be granted unless, within the period of 4 months after the notification day (i.e. **5 August 2023**), a native title party lodges an objection with the National Native Title Tribunal against the inclusion of the statement that the State considers the grant of the licence is an act attracting the expedited procedure. 

Further information regarding how to file a Form 5 is available from www.fedcourt.gov.au. After **18 July 2023**, you will need to seek leave from the Federal Court to become a party.

Under the *Native Title Act 1993* (Cth) there can be only one determination of native title for a particular area. If a person with native title rights and interests does not become a party to any of these applications, there may be no other opportunity for the Federal Court, in making its determinations, to take into account those native title rights and interests in relation to the areas concerned.

Each application was filed on 27 October 2022 and the Native Title Registrar has **accepted** each application for registration.

NOTICE EASTERN MAAR PEOPLES (VID21/2019) NATIVE TITLE AUTHORISATION MEETING

Background

The Eastern Maar Peoples have made a claimant application to the Federal Court of Australia seeking recognition of their native title rights and interests under the Native Title Act 1993 (Cth) ('NTA'). The claim is called *Janice Austin & Ors on behalf of the Eastern Maar Peoples (VID21/2019)* ('Eastern Maar Native Title Claim').

On 28 March 2023, the Eastern Maar Peoples native title rights and interests were recognised by the Federal Court of Australia through a Consent Determination over the uncontested portions depicted in the map below. The uncontested portions are those within the boundary shown that are not shaded and/or marked either 'A', 'B', 'C', 'D' or 'E'.

The shaded area to the west marked 'C' is referred to as 'Area C'. On 19 October 2022, the Gunditjmara Native Title Claim (VID620/2022) was lodged in the Federal Court of Australia and overlaps Area C. The Court has ordered the Gunditjmara Native Title Claim (VID620/2022) be heard at the same time as the Eastern Maar Native Title Claim, because both applications claim native title rights and interests in Area C. To resolve this, the applications are listed for hearing in the Federal Court, commencing 1 May 2023.

The purpose of the hearing is to determine whether native title rights and interests over Area C should be held by both the Eastern Maar People and the Gunditjmara People (as defined in the Gunditjmara Native Title Claim (VID620/2022)).

This is a meeting for the native title claim group to receive legal advice about the hearing and make decisions regarding it.

THIS NOTICE INVITES all members of the native title claim group as described below to attend the native title Authorisation Meeting at the date time and location below.



PROPOSAL TO GRANT PETROLEUM EXPLORATION PERMIT

The application is located in the Carnarvon Basin in the Pilbara region at approximately 142 kilometres south-west of Onslow and at approximately 123 kilometres north-east of Carnarvon. The application covers a total of 82.5' x 5' graticular blocks, 76 within the one million map sheet SF50 (Hamersley Range) and 6 within the one million map sheet SG50 (Meekatharra) for a total area of 6444.3 km². The north-west corner (114°30'4.73"E ; 22°59'55.37"S) of the application is situated approximately 5 kilometres south-east of the Marrilla homestead and 11 kilometres south-west of the intersection between North West Coastal Highway with Burkett Road. The north-east corner (115°0'4.74"E ; 22°54'55.36"S) of the application is located approximately 13 kilometres north-west of the Woggola/Nyang homesteads and 7 kilometres south-east of the intersection between North West Coastal Highway with Towera Road. The south-east corner (115°0'4.78"E ; 24°4'55.39"S) of the application is situated approximately 29 kilometres south-west of the Williambury homestead and approximately 31 kilometres south-east of the Middalya homestead. A technical description of the boundaries of the proposed permit area can be provided on request.

Nature Of The Act: The proposed act is the grant of a petroleum exploration permit pursuant to section 32 of the *Petroleum and Geothermal Energy Resources Act 1967 (WA)*. Community Workshops: March – April 2023



The Office of the Registrar, ALRA ('ORALRA') is currently undertaking an Aboriginal Owners Research Project in the Kamay Botany Bay area. The project will ultimately allow Aboriginal people to register as Aboriginal Owners for the Kamay Botany Bay National Park and Towra Nature Reserve, under Part 9 of the *Aboriginal Land Rights Act 1983 (ALRA)*.

ORALRA is running a series of **community workshops** in **March and April 2023** to present the key elements of the research project to date. The **draft cultural area map** and **draft list of Original Aboriginal Inhabitants** ('OAs') have been revised and expanded (based on information and feedback from community and further research). The revised cultural area and the OA list remain 'drafts' for further feedback from community and research. The ORALRA will also be discussing a **draft statement of cultural association** which is based on information from community members and participants, and expert anthropological advice.

These workshops will provide an opportunity for community members to discuss these matters, ask questions, and provide feedback and further information to the ORALRA. The dates and times for these workshops are as follows:
