

Cherrybrook Station Precinct, Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Study – Invitation to Register an Interest

Artefact Heritage has been engaged by Warren and Mahoney on behalf of the Department of Planning and Environment (DPE), to prepare an Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Study for the Urban Design and Planning Package – Cherrybrook Station Precinct – State-led Rezoning Project. The Urban Design and Planning Package will support the rezoning of the broader Cherrybrook Station Precinct.

The study area is bounded by Coonara Avenue/Edward Bennett Drive to the east and Highs Road/County Drive to the west and Dalketh Road and Ridgemont Close to the north. The area includes the land to the north of Castle Hill Road within the Hornsby Shire Council and land to the south of Castle Hill Road within The Hills Shire Council Area. The study area falls within the boundary of the Metropolitan Local Aboriginal Land Council (Metro LALC).

The Urban Design and Planning Package requires the inclusion of an Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Study including consultation with Aboriginal stakeholders guided by the Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Consultation Requirements for Proponents 2020 (the Consultation Requirements). The proponent wishes to consult with any Aboriginal persons or organisations that hold cultural knowledge relevant to determining the significance of Aboriginal objects and places in the locality.


An application has been made to the Federal Court of Australia (Federal Court) seeking a determination of compensation for the loss, impairment, diminution or extinguishment of native title rights and interests in the area described below.

The **compensable acts** for which compensation is claimed are:

- (1) the granting of Mineral Leases 1121 to 1126 and Exploration Licence 8078 on 5 January 1993 pursuant to the *Mining Act 1980* (NT) and the *McArthur River Project Agreement Ratification Act 1992* (NT), and validated on 30 June 1993 by s 3 of the *McArthur River Project Agreement Ratification Amendment Act 1993* (NT);
- (2) the regranting of Mineral Leases 1121 to 1126 and Exploration Licence 8078 on 30 June 1993 by s 4A of the *McArthur River Project Agreement Ratification Act 1992* (NT) (as amended by the *McArthur River Project Agreement Ratification Amendment Act 1993* (NT));
- (3) the authorising of mining activity of any kind on 4 May 2007 by s 4AB of *McArthur River Project Agreement Ratification Act 1992* (NT) (as amended by the *McArthur River Project Agreement Ratification Act 2007* (NT)), which includes the authorising of the conversion of the Mine from an underground into an open-cut mine with the associated diversion of McArthur River, Barney Creek and Surprise Creek;
- (3A) the granting of the Mining Interests over 1994 to 2020;
- (4) the: (a) granting of the Non-Pastoral Permits; (b) [*not reproduced in the application*]; (c) construction or establishment of the Road; (d) granting of Pipeline Licence No. 17 for construction or establishment of the Pipeline;
- whether or not done under the *McArthur River Project Agreement Ratification Act 1992* (NT);
- (5) such other acts within the application area done under the *McArthur River Project Agreement Ratification Act 1992* (NT) in connection with the Project inconsistent with the continued existence, enjoyment or exercise of the native title rights and interests in relation to that area.

Once a compensation application has been made under the *Native Title Act 1993* (Cth), and if there is no determination of native title in the area covered by the application, the Federal Court must make a concurrent determination about whether or not native title exists in that particular area. If the Federal Court decides that native title has not been extinguished, it must decide who holds the native title. If native title rights and interests are found to have been affected, the Federal Court must determine whether any compensation is payable.

Proposed new name for Littleton National Park

The Department of Environment and Science (the department) is proposing to rename Littleton National Park to Tagalaka National Park.

Tagalaka is the traditional name used by the registered native title holders for the area and refers to the Country which includes Littleton National Park. The native title rights and interests of the Tagalaka People were first recognised in the native title determinations on 10 December 2012.

Tagalaka People have an ongoing connection to this Country and engage in cooperative management of the National Park with the department. Aboriginal cultural sites are a significant value on the park.

After extensive consultation with the Tagalaka People they have requested that the name of Littleton National Park is changed to '**Tagalaka National Park**'.


