



6. STATEMENTS FOR THE PURPOSE OF THE NTA

(a) For the purposes of section 24EB(1)(c) of the NTA and regulation 7(5)(b) of the ILUA Regulations, the Parties agree that Subdivision P, Division 3, Part 2 of the NTA is not intended to apply to the Agreed Acts.

Government Agency means any federal, Territory or local government authority or statutory body or regulator;

ILUA Area means the area to which this Agreement applies as described in Schedule 1 and depicted on the plan at Schedule 2;

ILUA Regulations means the *Native Title (Indigenous Land Use Agreement) Regulations 1999* (Cth);

Project means all activities, works and operations to develop, construct, install, use, operate, maintain, replace and further develop infrastructure comprising a rock groyne, floating pontoon, careening facility, jetty, and any supporting infrastructure incidental thereto;

(i) from any Government Agency; and

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Objections to the registration of an ILUA where the application for registration has been certified:

This application for registration of an indigenous land use agreement (ILUA) has been certified by the Northern Land Council, the representative body for the area. Any person claiming to hold native title to any part of the area covered by the ILUA may object in writing within the notice period to the registration of this agreement if they think that the application to register the ILUA has not been properly certified. If you wish to object to the registration of this agreement (and you hold or claim to hold native title in any part of the area covered by the agreement) you may only object for one reason: in your view, the application to register the ILUA has not been properly certified, as stated in section 203BE(5)(a), (b) and (c) of the *Native Title Act 1993* (Cth). You must make this objection in writing and send it to the **Native Title Registrar, National Native Title Tribunal, PO Box 8133 Cairns QLD 4870** by **20 March 2024**. Generally, procedural fairness will require that the material you provide is given to certain other persons or organisations for comment. It may also be taken into account in the registration of other ILUAs and claimant applications and thus be provided to relevant persons or organisations for comment.

Public Notice of Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Assessment/AHIP Process Bulagaranda (Mt Yarrowyck) Aboriginal Area

Mt Yarrowyck Nature Reserve was handed back to its Traditional Aboriginal Owners in late 2021 and is now known as Bulagaranda (Mt Yarrowyck) Aboriginal Area (AA) and is under the management direction of a board of management (BoM) comprising of a majority Aboriginal Owners as specified in the Act. The Bulagaranda AA contains a number of known Aboriginal sites including stone artefacts and Aboriginal rock art sites.

It is the intention of the BoM, led by Aboriginal Owners, that several conservation and education upgrades occur on Bulagaranda. The intention of these upgrades is to better protect Aboriginal cultural heritage (ACH) values within the reserve and improve ACH education opportunities. The proposed works include: upgrading the existing viewing platform at one of the rock art sites, reinstating an improved scenic loop walking track, and upgrading the picnic area.

Before the proposed works begin, a formalised Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Assessment Report (ACHAR) will be completed. As part of the assessment process, Aboriginal consultation will be undertaken in accordance with the *Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Consultation Requirements for Proponents* (DECCW 2010) to assist the Minister with determining an Aboriginal Heritage Impact Permit (AHIP) application for Bulagaranda AA.
