

The Civic Precinct, Newcastle, NSW – Preparation of an Aboriginal cultural heritage assessment report for Proposed Public Domain Plan Submission

Public Notice and Registration of Interest National Parks and Wildlife Act 1974

City Plan heritage have been engaged by Place Design Group on behalf of the City of Newcastle Council to prepare an Aboriginal cultural heritage assessment report for the Civic Precinct in Newcastle to inform a Public Domain Plan Submission. The Civic Precinct is bounded by Union Street in the west, King Street and Civic Park to the south, and Darby Street in the East. The northern boundary follows an indirect line between Centenary Road, Workshop Way, and Civic Lane. The site is approximately 15.6ha in area. The proposed Public Domain Plan and subsequent ancillary works may result in impacts upon Aboriginal objects protected under the National Parks and Wildlife Act 1974 and will therefore require the preparation of an Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Assessment Report. This notice is given in accordance with the requirements of section 29 of the Native Title Act 1993 (Commonwealth).

Description of the nature of the act

Pursuant to the Native Title (Right to Negotiate (Exclusion) – NSW Land) Determination No. 1 of 1996 (Cth), Exploration Licences 8159, 8160 & 8405 include a condition to the effect that the holder must not prospect on any land or waters covered by the licences in relation to which native title exists without the prior written consent of the Minister administering the Mining Act 1992 (the 'Native Title Condition').

The licences contain a condition that the holder must not prospect on any land or waters on which native title exists without the prior consent of the Minister administering the Mining Act 1992. 





POONINDIE CEMETERY WORKS

APPLICATION FOR AUTHORISATIONS UNDER SECTIONS 21 AND 23 OF THE ABORIGINAL HERITAGE ACT 1988 (SA)

The Minister for Aboriginal Affairs (Minister), who is responsible for the *Aboriginal Heritage Act 1988 (SA)* (Act), has received an application for authorisations under sections 21 and 23 of the Act from District Council of Lower Eyre Peninsula (Applicant) to carry out upgrade works at the Poonindie Cemetery, some 17 km north of Port Lincoln.

Section 21 makes it an offence to excavate land to uncover any Aboriginal site, object or ancestral remains (together, heritage) without authorisation under the Act, while section 23 makes it an offence to damage, disturb or interfere with heritage without authorisation under the Act.

The Poonindie Cemetery formed part of the former Poonindie Mission that was operated by the Church of England from 1850 to 1894. The former Poonindie Mission holds historical significance for many Aboriginal families across South Australia, and potentially other parts of Australia, who have historical connections to the mission, and whose ancestors may be interred at the cemetery. The Poonindie Cemetery is listed as an Aboriginal heritage site on Aboriginal Affairs and Reconciliation's (AAR's) central archives.

Prior to considering whether to grant any authorisation under the Act, section 13 requires the Minister to take all reasonable steps to consult with the State Aboriginal Heritage Committee, Traditional Owners and any other Aboriginal parties with an interest.
