


National Native Title Tribunal

This is an application by a native title claim group which is asking the Federal Court of Australia (Federal Court) to determine that the group holds native title in the area described below.

If you want to become a party to this application, you must file a Form 5 (Notice of Intention to become a Party) with the Federal Court, **on or before 8 January 2025**. Further information regarding how to file a Form 5 is available from www.fedcourt.gov.au. After **8 January 2025**, you will need to seek leave from the Federal Court to become a party.

Under the *Native Title Act 1993* (Cth) there can be only one determination of native title for a particular area. If a person with native title rights and interests does not become a party to this application, there may be no other opportunity for the Federal Court, in making its determination, to take into account those native title rights and interests in relation to the area concerned.




National Native Title Tribunal

This is an application by the Jidi Jidi Aboriginal Corporation RNTBC, asking the Federal Court of Australia (Federal Court) to vary a determination of native title (Relevant Determination) in the area described below.

The applicant seeks orders under s 13(5) of the *Native Title Act 1993* (Cth), that the Relevant Determination be varied to remove areas covered by certain pastoral lease improvements and mining leases currently listed in the Second Schedule of the determination as areas where native title has been extinguished. The effect of the variation sought would be to recognise native title over those areas on and from the date of the variation.

Nature of the act: Grant of amalgamation applications which authorises the applicant to explore for minerals.

The 3 month period closes on **25 December 2024**. Any person who is, or becomes a native title party, is entitled to the negotiation and/or procedural rights provided in Part 2 Division 3 Subdivision P of the *Native Title Act 1993 (Cth)*. Nature of the act: Grant of mining leases, which authorises the applicant to mine for minerals for a term of 21 years from notification of grant and a right of renewal for 21 years. Grant of exploration licences, which authorises the applicant to explore for minerals for a term of 5 years from the date of grant.

Notification day: **25 September 2024**

Native title parties: Under section 30 of the *Native Title Act 1993 (Cth)*, persons have until 3 months after the notification day to take certain steps to become native title parties in relation to applications. The 3 month period closes on **25 December 2024**. Any person who is, or becomes a native title party, is entitled to the negotiation and/or procedural rights provided in Part 2 Division 3 Subdivision P of *Native Title Act 1993 (Cth)*. The mining tenements may be granted if, by the end of the period of 4 months after the notification day (i.e. **25 January 2025**), there is no native title party under section 30 of the *Native Title Act 1993 (Cth)* in relation to the area of the mining tenements.
