Where is it based?

A variety of onsite and remote positions are available for the right candidates. As a marker, you will have the flexibility to work from our marking centre at the Canterbury Park Racecourse in Sydney or from home.

When will you be needed?

If you are interested in working remotely, you have great flexibility in determining your work hours and have the option to mark at any time between the hours of 7 AM to 10 PM.

For those interested in working onsite, you will need to be available 6 days a week, including weekend, with the flexibility to select for either a Day (8 AM to 3 PM) or Evening shift (4 PM to 8:45 PM).

The live marking period will begin in mid-March and is expected to continue until the end of April. Training will take place in the week of Monday 13 March 2023 (final dates to be confirmed), with live marking beginning immediately after the training period is completed.

Our test centre is closed during the Easter public holiday.
