Applications now open for Board vacancies

Help protect the public and set national standards for registered health practitioners

National Boards regulate Australia's 850,000 registered health practitioners and 180,000 registered students across 16 health professions. These Boards consist of community members and practitioner members (who are registered in the relevant profession) and set the professional standards practitioners must meet to be registered.

Applications are now open for 10 Board positions.

Registered health practitioners and members of the community across Australia are warmly invited to apply for upcoming vacancies on the National Boards for:

- Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander health practice
- Chiropractic*
- Medical radiation practice
- Nursing and midwifery*
- Osteopathy*
- Podiatry
- Psychology

* Registered practitioners from these professions are eligible to apply for the position of **Board Chair**.

We are committed to increasing Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander Peoples' leadership and voices on National Boards and warmly invite Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander persons to apply.

All appointments are made by state, territory and federal Health Ministers for up to three years, under the Health Practitioner Regulation National Law, as in force in each state and territory.
