Koorie Engagement Support Officer position in Loddon Campaspe Area, North-Western Victoria Region

The Victorian Department of Education & Training is seeking a suitably qualified Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander person to work in the North-Western Victoria Region in the positions of Koorie Engagement Support Officers.

The positions will support schools and early childhood services and will be part of the regional Koorie Education Workforce responsible for the implementation of the Marrung Aboriginal Education Plan 2016-2026.

The role includes building the capability of schools to strengthen a culturally safe learning environment for Koorie children and young people from early childhood to school completion and supporting families, children and young people to fully engage with their learning. Successful applicants should possess strong leadership skills to ensure the successful delivery of educational support services. They will be required to provide advice to schools, kindergartens, families and the Koorie community on strategies for improving educational outcomes for Koorie children and young people.

Applicants must have a high level of understanding of Koorie education and community needs, and knowledge of Koorie culture. Suitable qualifications are desirable.
