### **Nurse Home Visitor (Re-Advertised)** **Hours Negotiable: 30-38 hours per week**

Rumbalara Aboriginal Cooperative, Health & Wellbeing Services are seeking an enthusiastic and dedicated Registered Nurse for the role of Nurse Home Visitor. Working alongside a Family Partnership Worker, this role requires you to deliver the Australian Nurse-Family Partnership Program (ANFPP) to first time mothers in a home setting.

ANFPP is an evidence-based home visiting program with a focus on early emotional and physical health intervention, and improving the life course and positive outcomes for women pregnant with an Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander baby. The program is voluntary for all eligible women and involves regular culturally appropriate home visits during pregnancy, infancy and until the child's second birthday.

The Nurse Home Visitor works within the Home Visiting Team for the delivery of program content, building therapeutic relationships, stakeholder engagement and health promotion. All ANFPP staff receive intensive training in the ANFPP home visit guidelines, screening tools and related materials to best support parents in improving pregnancy outcomes, improving child health and development, and supporting parents to develop a vision for their own futures.

**What you need to apply:**

- Register Nurse with a current AHPRA registration

- Experience and/or studies towards antenatal care, neonatal care, midwifery, child health or family centred practice
- Experience in the delivery of nursing services in a home, school or community visiting service environment
