The Home Ownerships Program is a government funded initiative that aims to increase and support home ownership opportunities for Aboriginal people, communities and families in NSW.

As the Program Manager, you will play a critical role in lending your financial and banking expertise to assist the Aboriginal people and community with the home lending and ownership.

This is a complex role that will see you balancing targets and fiscal responsibility in supporting people into home ownership in what is a volatile housing market. You will also be required to manage complex and sensitive consultations and negotiations with a diverse range of stakeholders.

This is an Aboriginal Identified role where Aboriginal identity, cultural knowledge or connections are a genuine aspect of the role. Positions are specifically noted under the provisions of the NSW Anti-discrimination Act (1977).

About You

Ideally, you will have a strong financial or banking background with demonstrated experience in home lending and financial literacy with regards to home ownership. You will also be an excellent project manager and communicator with the ability to maintain effective stakeholder relationships through strong collaboration, negotiation and conflict resolution skills.

You will also possess strong leadership skills with the ability to motivate and inspire team members working remotely. Expertise relating to the monitoring and evaluation of Aboriginal programs and initiatives will be highly regarded.
