Sutherland, St George and Prince of Wales Hospitals Occupational Therapy and Physiotherapy teams are seeking team members that are motivated to provide best possible compassionate care to our community. As an allied health assistant, working with an Occupational Therapist, or a Physiotherapist, you will provide support to deliver health care to people in hospital. Your day includes working with clients on their therapy program, setting up equipment, and communicating with many people at the hospital.

This is a targeted Aboriginal position in accordance with the GSE Act Rule 26, Employment of Eligible Persons. Aboriginal people are encouraged to apply, and preference will be given to applicants of Aboriginal descent who meet the selection criteria, to improve access to employment and career opportunity. Aboriginal applicants must demonstrate Aboriginality in addition to addressing the selection criteria.

In the event there are no suitable Aboriginal applicants then applicants from non-Aboriginal applicants will be considered.

An eligibility list for Allied Health Assistants for Occupational Therapy and, or Physiotherapy will be created from this process. Applicants selected for the eligibility list may be offered permanent, temporary, or casual roles that become available, at St George Hospital, Sutherland Hospital and Prince of Wales Hospital.

- 1. Do you identify as Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander? If so, please tell us about your Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander heritage, including a brief description of your family and community connections.
- 2. Certificate IV in Allied Health Assistance, or equivalent work experience and a willingness to work towards certification with the support of SESLHD.
- 3. Proven interpersonal, written and verbal communication skills.
- 4. Computer literacy or a willingness to learn.
- 5. Demonstrated ability to be self-directed and work with minimum supervision, to organise work priorities and manage time effectively.
- 6. Knowledge and understanding of Work Health and Safety legislation and principles.
- 7. OT positions: Current Class C NSW drivers licence (or equivalent).
