The Secondary Education Initiatives Advisor provides high level support and advice across directorates to improve educational outcomes for Aboriginal Education and in particular to support secondary schools to progress the achievement of the Premier's Priority to increase the percentage of students attaining a HSC by 50% by 2023, while maintaining their cultural identity.

This position is targeted to the employment of an Aboriginal person and is authorised by the Department's EEO Management Plan in accordance with Part 9A of the *Anti-Discrimination Act 1977*.
