SNAICC – who are we and what do we do?

Established in 1981, **SNAICC – National Voice for our Children** is the national non-government peak body for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander children. SNAICC's vision is that Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander children, young people and families are protected, our communities determine their own futures, and our cultural identity is valued. We work to amplify the voice of community and the sector for the fulfilment of the rights of our children.

SNAICC plays a key role in the following areas:

- Research and policy development, with high-level leadership, policy papers and sector representation
- Training and resource design, development and delivery including topics such as early childhood development, partnerships, family support, trauma, and cultural competency.
- Support for sector development, membership, and networking.

About the role:

The Senior Project Advisor will support SNAICC as it commences multiple streams of work with the Department of Education on the Connected Beginnings and Community Child Care Fund Restricted (CCCFR) Expansion projects. The three streams of work include:

- New CCCFR sites scoping and community readiness assessment.
- Foundational Support for 27 new Connected Beginnings sites, 20 new CCCFR Expansion sites and approximately 14-24 existing/established Connected Beginnings sites.
- Ongoing support for all sites.

The Senior Project Advisor will be responsible for planning out and ensuring the effective delivery of the streams of work focused on CCCFR, with the assistance of a Project Officer, and under the guidance of the National Project Manager.

Connected Beginnings and CCCFR Expansion:

SNAICC is the Community Partner for the Commonwealth Govt. funded 's *Connected Beginnings* and *Community Child Care Fund Restricted (CCCFR) Expansion* programs.

SNAICC's *Connected Beginnings* and *Community Child Care Fund Restricted (CCCFR) Expansion* unit supports placed based programs that aim to:

- improve outcomes for First Nation's children 0 - 5 years so they have a strong start in life and school and start school happy, healthy, and ready to learn; and
- close the gap in school readiness and education outcomes between First Nations children and non-First Nations children.
