## Victoria Police job opportunities

First Nations Peoples have been calling for a truth-telling process for generations. In response, the Victorian Government established the Yoorrook Justice Commission on 12 May 2021.

The Commission is the first formal truth-telling process into injustices experienced by First Peoples in Victoria. It is due to issue an interim report in June 2022 and the final report in June 2024.

Victoria Police has acknowledged the important work that needs to be done and has established the Yoorrook Justice Commission Response Taskforce to lead our support for this significant Royal Commission.

The **Victoria Police Yoorrook Justice Commission Response is seeking new team members** to undertake a diverse range of strategic project work to support the work of the Yoorrook Justice Commission.

These roles are a unique opportunity to work in new and innovative ways and contribute to the ground-breaking work of Truth, Treaty, Self-Determination and Cultural Rights.

We also have several designated positions available at the VPS 2, 4 and 5 levels. In accordance with Section 12 of the *Equal Opportunity Act 2010*, only Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people are eligible to apply for designated positions.
