



Positions Vacant – ABC non-executive Directors

Applications are invited to fill two upcoming vacancies in the role of non-executive Director on the Australian Broadcasting Corporation (ABC) Board.

The successful candidates will have demonstrated high-level leadership and vision as well as a commitment to the highest standards of governance and personal and professional integrity. Candidates must demonstrate an understanding of the media environment and the ABC Act, including the Charter of the Corporation.

The application process will be conducted by an independent panel. At the end of the process the panel will provide a report containing a short-list of at least three nominated candidates for the roles to the Minister for Communications, Cyber Safety and the Arts. The Minister will then make a recommendation to the Governor-General who has responsibility for appointing non-executive Directors to the ABC Board.

The principles of equal opportunity and diversity will apply to this process.
