The successful applicant will divide their time between two funded research projects relating to urban Indigenous development, so although this is a full-time position, there is scope for the position to be divided into two part-time positions and applicants interested in a part-time appointment are also encouraged to apply.

We are seeking someone with high-level qualitative and/or quantitative research skills, a strong record of publications in peer-reviewed books, journals and policy-focused reports, and a demonstrated capacity to build strong relationships with Indigenous communities and organisations, researchers, and policy makers. The successful candidate will also have demonstrated success in applying for competitive grants and in carrying out commissioned research. CAEPR is a highly collaborative research environment and we are seeking a colleague with experience in and commitment to collaborative research.
