The Research Associate will undertake research under the supervision of relevant academic staff and will be linked to mentors who will assist and guide their development. The major areas of focus will be to build their own academic and contributing to the broader program of work. The position is for a period of five years with a possible pathway into an Academic career within ANU. The position will be full-time undertaking research, with the option of undertaking postgraduate studies (Masters or PhD). This position will sit in the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Health Program, within the National Centre for Epidemiology and Population Health, one of five centres within the Research School of Population Health (RSPH). This Aboriginal-Led program conducts cutting-edge innovative and multidisciplinary large-scale research in areas across the social and cultural determinants of Indigenous health and wellbeing. The approach across the program is to conduct research in partnership with Indigenous individuals, communities, and organisations.

The Research Associate will actively contribute to all aspects of the Program's work with an emphasis on being concurrently enrolled in a higher degree research program at RSPH, with the research topic harmonised with their duties. If the successful candidate is eligible for acceptance into an ANU PhD program with the relevant School within three months of appointment, you may be considered for an Academic Associate position.
