The Indigenous Convenor will report to the Head of School and work closely with the Open School of Music Convenor and Open School professional staff, to develop programs that engage and develop the musical talents of Canberra's local indigenous community.

The successful candidate will require sound knowledge of various musical genres – particularly contemporary music – and will in addition have the ability to assist with programs that provide tuition in music production and recording techniques and other music technology as appropriate.
