This will include consultation with key stakeholders, qualitative data collection across Queensland using Indigenous research methods, data analysis, sharing findings with academic and community audiences, and developing policy and practice solutions. This position requires the incumbent to travel.

The Research Officer will work collegially with other staff in the National Centre for Epidemiology and Population Health across the University and with external stakeholders. The Research Officer will be supported to develop and maintain highly effective relationships with a range of government, non-government and community health organisations, and contribute to collaborative research and teaching within RSPH.
