About the Role

This is an exciting opportunity to join the ABC's newly established ABC Archives Indigenous Unit in a curatorial role. The unit has been established to interpret and describe the ABC Archives collection from an Indigenous perspective and to further develop a strategy and set of guidelines for managing Indigenous collections.

The ABC is custodian of invaluable content, reflecting the culture, traditions, history, language and art of Australia's first nations people. It's presented from a variety of viewpoints including stories told from a non-Aboriginal perspective. The content created by, for and about Australia's first people is a unique and rich legacy that is worthy of protection and management.

The unit will be responsible for managing this content and working with other collecting agencies to identify common issues around archiving process and metadata requirements. The unit will also look to surface and prioritise Indigenous voices from within the ABC Archives collection. The team will work with program makers to identify opportunities for the ABC Archive to be used and repurposed in ways that are culturally appropriate and respectful.

You will have good general knowledge and research skills as well as collection management knowledge.
