Key Duties

The Senior Accountant (Taxation) will be expected to fulfill the following duties (but not limited to):

- Ensure local and overseas tax lodgements are completed on time, including assisting with any related local audits
- Review tax compliance obligations in prospective jurisdictions through use of online resources, and overseas tax agents as required
- Review and promote integrity in foreign VAT/TAX recording in the finance system
- Promote correct VAT/TAX recording through training of in-country Accounts Payable and Procurement teams
- Manage process and establish reports within Accounts Payable
- Validate that internal controls are implemented and operational
