Details: Flexible Education is a community of schools and programs that are co-located within several settings including Murrumbidgee Education and Training Centre, Boomanulla, Muliyan Program, Hospital School, the educational program at The Cottage and Distance Education. Flexible Education provides holistic educational and wellbeing services to students and families who may be disengaged from education and/or have complex needs. To ensure that the holistic needs of students and families are met Flexible Education has a strong commitment to working together with community agencies, lead workers, families, and each student.

The successful applicant will be required to Develop and deliver a range of programs that support student engagement and build partnerships between the school and community agencies. Promote access to appropriate community based youth support services and programs.

Eligibility/Other Requirements:
