RecruitAbility applies to this vacancy. Under the RecruitAbility scheme you will be invited to participate in further assessment activity for the vacancy if you choose to apply under the scheme; declare you have a disability; and meet the minimum requirements for the job.

Graduates commence at the APS3 level (\$63,320 per annum plus superannuation). On successful completion of the Graduate Program graduates will have their performance assessed and may be advanced within the MDBA's Graduate Broadband (APS4 – APS5), with a salary range of \$70,716 - \$87,385 per annum plus superannuation.
