Duties

We are seeking a high performing and talented Director to lead our Ethics and Research Leadership team. You will be responsible for leading a small team to provide ethics services, develop programs and conduct research that underpins our Code of Ethics for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Research and you will be responsible for building our relationships with the research and academic community.

You will be part of the management team of the Research and Education Group, which provides leadership in research and ethical engagement and informs Indigenous and government decision-making and nation building. As part of a dynamic Indigenous research management team, you will develop and lead new projects and initiatives, which will diversify your work over time. You will also provide intellectual leadership and develop the research capability across the group and contribute excellent research.

Approval may be granted to maintain the annual salary for an existing Australian Public Service employee transferring to the Institute whose current annual salary exceeds the above salary range.

Affirmative Measures

This will be filled using the Affirmative Measures provision, which allows for the targeted recruitment of Indigenous Australians into the Australian Public Service. The vacancy is only open to Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander people. The filling of this employment opportunity is intended to constitute an affirmative measure under section 8(1) of the Racial Discrimination Act 1975.
