Research and Education Group - various positions (Affirmative Measures)

Candidates who have submitted applications for recent vacancies in our Research and Education Group do not need to re-apply as you will be considered for this selection round.

AIATSIS has various ongoing and non-ongoing vacancies including specialist and generalist roles across various classifications (APS4 to EL1) within the Research and Education Group.

Some positions require essential qualifications which are outlined in the Application Pack relevant to that job.

This recruitment process will be used to fill both ongoing and non-ongoing positions across various sections. If an offer of non-ongoing employment is made, the successful applicant may be employed for an initial period of 18 months with the possibility of extension up to a maximum period of three years in total.

A merit pool may be established through this selection process, which is valid for a period of twelve months from the date the vacancy was advertised in the Public Service Gazette.

Affirmative Measures

This will be filled using the Affirmative Measures provision, which allows for the targeted recruitment of Indigenous Australians into the Australian Public Service. The vacancy is only open to Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander people. The filling of this employment opportunity is intended to constitute a special measure under section 8(1) of the Racial Discrimination Act 1975.
