DDACL is a small community controlled health organisation run by a community elected Board of Directors. It provides a range of services including health and allied health services, family services, housing, aged and disability care, health promotion and more.

On joining DDACL you will enjoy many benefits including flexible work arrangements, a cultural mentor onsite, salary sacrificing, use of company vehicles and free parking onsite, learning and development opportunities, a great team culture and more.

Please note this is a 12 month maternity leave position working 25 hours a week during school terms. Salary is based on SCHADS Award level 3.

- Plan and facilitate weekly activities aimed at strengthening and connecting Koori Young People by exploring issues are health, respect and safety.
- Connect young Aboriginal people to the Dandenong & District Aborigines Co-operative and to other Aboriginal services to increase their sense of belonging and engagement with Aboriginal community and targeted Aboriginal services.
- Work with teachers and schools to ensure:
  - o program participants actively engage with their peers and school community;
  - o issues and concerns affecting program participants are addressed;
  - o access to the program by Aboriginal girls
