The Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade (DFAT) is seeking energetic and talented people at the Executive Level 2 to contribute to the development and implementation of trade policy across all aspects of the department's operations. This includes bilateral, multilateral and plurilateral trade negotiations; trade advocacy; and stakeholder engagement.

You will provide a significant contribution to strategic planning and policy development across DFAT. You will be expected to plan and control the work of a section, manage a diverse team of staff and contribute to the development of strategic advice on trade policy and trade negotiations. This role may require regular travel.

Candidates must be Australian citizens.

An interview is a critical part of the security clearance process. The interview method (i.e. face-to-face or video conferencing) will be assessed on a case-by-case basis, taking into account advice from the Australian Government Department of Health and relevant state and territory governments.

Depending on the role into which you are placed, you may be required to obtain and maintain a Working with Vulnerable People/Children registration (or equivalent).
