The section also provides oversight of external fraud against DFAT (excluding passport fraud). This includes administration of referrals from external organisations and advice to colleagues across the department.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Candidates must be Australian citizens.

Depending on the role into which you are placed, you may be required to obtain and maintain a Working with Vulnerable People/Children registration (or equivalent).
