The department is seeking talented and motivated individuals to fill a number of positions at the Senior Executive Service Band 1 level.

The positions include roles across the department, requiring experience in foreign, trade, economic, development and/or legal policy. Successful candidates will be expected to be ready to serve in any position in the department in Canberra. While based in Canberra, the department expects to identify candidates to fill a number of Band 1 positions overseas as well, and successful candidates should be ready to deploy at short notice. All positions may involve domestic and/or international travel and representing Australia overseas.

You will be required to demonstrate a strong record of leadership, management skills and the delivery of outcomes. Experience in leading multi-disciplinary teams would be an asset. You will formulate, implement and interpret policies across the range of the department's responsibilities and manage complex programs and substantial resources (people, finances, information technology and property).

You will be required to represent and advocate Australia's interests in bilateral, regional and multilateral settings, and to be able to establish broad networks of individuals who are likely to have insight into and influence on issues of importance to Australia.

You will need to engage in a collaborative and productive way with other Australian and state government agencies on domestic and international policy issues. You will lead outreach and advocacy of Australia's international engagement to the Australian community and domestic stakeholders. You will need to show leadership in delivering DFAT's corporate reform agenda.
