GPTT is funded to deliver the Australian General Practice Training program (AGPT), and Aboriginal health strategic initiatives.

Based in Hobart and reporting to the Director of Education and Training, the Manager, Aboriginal Torres Strait Islander Health Training (ATSIHT) and Support has responsibility for the development, implementation, and evaluation of the Aboriginal Torres Strait Islander Health Training (ATSIHT) Plan that aligns with Commonwealth Grant funding. Working closely with our partner organisations and the GPTT Medical Education Team the Project Manager will further develop strategies and submissions that will build cultural awareness and training activities that supports future ATSIH outcomes.

This is a part time (22.5 hrs per week) fixed term position for a period until 31 December, 2022.

The successful applicant will have the ability to develop and implement new projects from planning, budgeting and implementation and communicate and engage effectively in a culturally appropriate manner with Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people, communities and organisations.
