The Indigenous Land and Sea Corporation (ILSC) is a corporate Commonwealth entity established under the ATSI Act and subject to the PGPA Act. The ILSC assists Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people to realise economic, social, cultural and environmental benefits that the ownership and management of land, water and water related rights can bring. The ILSC provides this assistance through the acquisition and management of rights and interests in land, salt water and freshwater country.

Through the Savanna Fire Management (SFM) Program, the ILSC works in partnership with Indigenous landholders to identify, develop and support the implementation of viable and sustainable fire-carbon enterprises on Indigenous-held land in the NT. Funds are available to support feasibility assessments, business planning, training, fire management operations and the purchase of relevant plant and equipment.

Under the direction of the Program Manager – SFM, the Project Advisor supports the delivery of the SFM Program in the Northern Territory.

In this role you will:

- work with groups funded by the SFM Program to assist in their delivery of a high-quality fire program that builds capacity and creates benefits for their community and the environment.
- Provide or source technical advice in best practice fire management for Indigenous groups participating in the SFM Program
- Assist in the feasibility assessment of new projects coming in to the SFM Program
- Undertake general program administration including cost and contract management

The Preferred applicant will be engaged on a 3 year non ongoing basis under the provision of the ILSC Enterprise Agreement.
