Responsibilities will include (but will not be limited to):

- Provide assistance with the transport and safe transfer of patients between departments, within the operating suite and to/from other local hospitals
- Correctly dispose of soiled linen, rubbish and biomedical waste from the theatre after each case/session
- Ensure Perioperative areas are kept clean including floors, walls, shelving and other areas as directed – this includes tearoom areas
- Courier Perioperative equipment between units, departments and hospitals if required
- Cleans patient related areas Theatre

- Previous training in Manual Handling and/or safe lifting techniques
