Flexible work location, can be based in any of MCCC's regional offices located in Bendigo, Wodonga, Geelong or Warrnambool.

Murray City Country Coast GP Training (MCCC) is a Regional Training Organisation (RTO) responsible for the management and delivery of specialist general practice training programs across North Western and North Eastern Victoria, the greater Albury region into Southern New South Wales, central Victoria, South Western Victoria and Northern and Western metropolitan Melbourne area which covers approximately 40 per cent of the population base of Melbourne.

We are recruiting for the position of **Aboriginal Health Liaison Officer**. The Aboriginal Liaison Officer will form strong working relationships with relevant community groups, health professionals, organisations and agencies. The role will report to the Cultural Educator and will work closely with the Program Manager, Aboriginal Health and Torres Strait Islander Health Program. The position can be based in any of our regional offices in Bendigo, Wodonga, Geelong, Warrnambool.

This role will include the following primary responsibilities:

- Work with MCCC's Cultural Educator and medical educators, as well as other staff to develop, design and deliver MCCC's cultural education program
- Contribute to the organisation-wide registrar training workshops/webinars by providing culturally specific advice to activities in the workshops and to registrars as required
- Contribute to the development of MCCC's annual Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Strategic Plan by working with the ACCHOs and providing their feedback to inform the plan
- Establish and maintain collaborative relationships with Aboriginal Medical Services in the region and other external stakeholders for example VACCHO, ACCHOs and Indigenous General Practice Registrars Network (IGPRN).
