



## Aboriginal Legal Access Program Worker

The Northern Rivers Community Legal Centre (NRCLC) is seeking to recruit to the role of **Aboriginal Legal Access Program Worker** based in Lismore. The primary role of the Aboriginal Legal Access Worker is to help build meaningful and trusted connections between the NRCLC and local Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities. Key to the role is community development practices to ensure access to justice and legal assistance. Applicants need to demonstrate knowledge of the over representation of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples in the justice system and a capacity to advocate for change both internal and external to the centre. You will be adaptable and driven to deliver results that contribute to the social determinants of social and emotional wellbeing.

NRCLC is a not-for-profit, non-government organisation operating from a social justice perspective. Our target client groups are those for whom access to justice is not equitable, including Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples, women experiencing domestic and family violence and people with disabilities.

**Permanent role 21 hours per week with the capacity to work 28 hours per week.**

The position is graded under the **SCHADS Award with a salary range of \$79,568 to \$85,568 pro-rata**, plus leave loading (dependent upon qualifications, skills and experience), plus superannuation and access to PBI Salary Packaging.

This role is open to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander applicants only. Aboriginality/Torres Strait Islander identity is a genuine occupational qualification for this role in accordance with Sections 14(d) of the Anti-Discrimination Act 1977.
