



Aboriginal Owners Research Project for Mungo National Park

The Office of the *Registrar Aboriginal Land Rights Act 1983* is currently running a research project to identify Aboriginal Owners for Mungo National Park.

The Registrar is required to maintain a Register of Aboriginal Owners for land in NSW. Aboriginal Owners are Aboriginal people who:

- 1 are directly descended from the original Aboriginal inhabitants of the cultural area in which the land is situated;
- 2 have a cultural association with the land that derives from the traditions, observances, customs, beliefs or history of the original Aboriginal inhabitants of the land; and
- 3 have consented to the entry of their name on the Register
