



2021 National Assessment Program Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) Marking

Pearson Assessment Services (PAS) is seeking expressions of interest from currently employed, recently retired, or casually employed teachers to participate in the marking of student responses for the 2021 National Assessment Program – Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN).

It is expected that applicants should have the following:

- an understanding of criterion-based marking (writing)
- a sound knowledge of grammar and its structures
- strong teaching experience (preferably a minimum of 1 – 2 years Australian experience)
- English teaching background
- Have previously been a NAPLAN marker **OR** completed either:
 - The NAPLAN Persuasive Writing Course*
 - or
 - The NAPLAN Narrative Writing Course*

* Both free courses are available on the NSW Education Standards Authority (NESA) Learning webpage (NESA Learning Page).

Training will take place on the week of the 17th of May, 2021. ***Final dates to be advised.***

Marking will begin immediately after the training period and continue until approximately mid to late June.

Markers are expected to attend every session from the start of training through to completion of the marking operation. Please note that marking may finish before the end of any published completion date.

Centre Based Marking

The marking location is expected to be at the Canterbury Park Racecourse. Confirmed information on the venue and dates will be kept up to date on the NAPLAN Marking Homepage and FAQ Page.

It is a requirement that markers are able to commit to the day or evening shift, and a weekend shift on Saturday or Sunday (8:00 AM - 3:00 PM).

Day shift: Monday - Friday 8:00 AM - 3:00 PM

Evening shift: Monday - Friday 4:00 PM - 8:45 PM

Pay Rate: \$50.19 per hour

Home Based Marking

Home-based marking opportunities are available for teachers residing in both metropolitan and regional New South Wales. It is a requirement that home-based markers are able to commit to a minimum of 4 hours of continuous marking per day, for a minimum of 6 days a week during the live marking period.
